

PEACEQUEST - COMPETITION FOR YOUTH

- 1) Essay Topics for Students: (Age Group from 15 to 25) and
- 2) Research Topics for Scholars: (Age Group 25 and above)

Evaluation Criteria:

- Argument Clarity (30): Coherence, philosophical depth.
- Relevance (25): Alignment with topic, SAARC context.
- Originality (20): Novel insights, creative approach.
- Evidence (15): Quality of sources, examples.
- Rotary Branding (10): Proper cover page, PI potential.

Evaluation Board:

The Evaluation Board will comprise of established personalities from various disciplines. The composition will be of seven members, which includes 2 – Rotarians, 2 – Philosophers, 1 – Peace Studies scholar, 1 – Youth representative, and 1 – Journal Editor.

- Essays Evaluation: 5 members (2 Rotarians, 2 Academics, 1 Youth).
- Papers Evaluation: 5 members (3 scholars, 1 Rotarian, 1 Editor).



PEACE ART FESTIVAL

Evaluation Criteria:

- Peace Message (30): Clarity and impact of peace narrative.
- Creativity (25): Originality, innovative use of medium.
- Technical Skill (20): Craftsmanship, composition, execution.
- Theme Alignment (15): Relevance to chosen theme.
- Rotary Branding (10): Inclusion of required label, PI potential.

Evaluation Board:

Committee: 5 members (2 Rotarians with art expertise, 1 local artist, 1 art historian, 1 community representative to reflect all ages).

Curation Process:

- Shortlist 100 entries
- Select 50–70 artworks for exhibition

Balance mediums (e.g., 30% paintings, 20% sculptures, 20% digital) and representation, with diverse age groups (e.g., teens, adults, seniors).

PEACE SHORT FILM COMPETITION

Evaluation Criteria:

- Story Impact (30): Emotional resonance, peace message clarity.
- Creativity (25): Originality, innovative storytelling.
- Technical Quality (20): Audio, visuals, editing.
- Theme Alignment (15): Relevance to chosen peace theme.
- Rotary Branding (10): Inclusion of required slide, PI enhancement.

Evaluation Board:

Jury Committee: 5 members (2 Rotarians, 2 filmmakers, 1 youth leader).

Curation Process:

• Shortlist: Top 20 films

Winners: 5 films would be selected, announced at Peace Conference
